POLICY STATEMENT

The aim of Glasgow School of Ballet is to ensure that all pupils experience dance in a fun, friendly, positive, and safe environment. To achieve this, please take note of the following guidelines.

TERM ENROLMENT

When enrolling your child in the school please be aware that you are committing to a **full 12week term**. NO REFUNDS will be given if you decide to remove your child from the class prior to the term ending. It is important that you are comfortable with this before enrolling your child in the school.

CLASS PROCEDURE:

Please read the below details carefully so you are comfortable with our class procedures.

When attending this class there are a few rules and regulations that must continue to be followed:

Parents –

- Please bring a change of shoes, either slippers, indoor trainers, or socks.
- All adults joining us in the class are absolutely welcome to participate, it is what makes it so much fun.

- Please wear something comfortable and suitable for movement.

Dancers -

- If your dancer doesn't have ballet shoes, please put something soft and nonslip on their feet, bare feet is now completely acceptable but it can be a little cold.
- Some nice comfy clothes or our ballet uniform would be great. We have some lovely options for uniforms on our uniform website plus we have some stock available to purchase in the school.
- We are looking into very cute Tiny Dancer merchandise too.

ENTRANCE

The entrance is at the side of the building on Deanston Drive and there will be staff there to welcome you. Please don't arrive too early as there is no access to the building prior to the class and if you are running late there may not be the opportunity to then attend that class. During the winter months we may close the external door before the class begins to try and keep the building warm for our dancers.
